### What is this product?

#### Type

This product is a share of an investment company qualifying as an undertaking for collective investment in transferable securities (UCITS).

#### Term

This sub-fund has no maturity date. However, the manufacturer may decide to close the sub-fund under certain circumstances.

#### Objectives

The objective of the sub-fund is to achieve a long-term performance close to that of stock market securities representative of the developed economies in the OECD, while the volatility is expected to remain lower than the long-term volatility of these securities, by means of daily management of market risk, monitored through several risk indicators based in particular on historical and prospective volatility. The sub-fund cannot guarantee that this objective will be achieved.

LUX-EQUITY LOW VOLATILITY invests mainly in shares issued by companies domiciled and/or listed in OECD member states.

These investments may be made directly and/or indirectly (for example by means of UCIs/equity UCITS):

- incidentally in cash;
- up to 25% of its net assets in other assets authorised under the Investment Restrictions in the prospectus (including other equities and UCIs/UCITS than those mentioned above, bonds and money market instruments).

The sub-fund's assets may include, for a minority part, securities of issuers domiciled and/or listed in emerging countries as well as UCIs/UCITS and/or other instruments authorised under the Investment Restrictions of the emerging market-oriented prospectus.

The sub-fund's strategy is to select low volatility securities. From this point of view, the sub-fund's portfolio is regularly subject to a process of optimising risk.

The sub-fund may use, for the purpose of good management and/or hedging, all derivative financial instruments (such as forex, futures, op-

tions, etc.) and other techniques/instruments set out in the Investment Restrictions in the prospectus and within the limits provided.

**Benchmark:** The portfolio is actively managed on a discretionary basis without reference to a benchmark.

#### Intended retail investor

The sub-fund is an equity-weighted sub-fund particularly suitable for an investor seeking long-term capital growth.

#### Other information

**Depositary:** Banque et Caisse d'Epargne de l'Etat, Luxembourg

**Dividend income:** This class is a capitalisation class meaning that income is reinvested.

**Conversion right:** The investor has the right to convert his investment in shares in one sub-fund for shares in the same sub-fund or in another sub-fund. The investor can obtain information about how to convert in the prospectus of the fund.

**Segregation:** The assets and liabilities of a sub-fund are segregated pursuant to the law so that the commitments and liabilities of one sub-fund do not affect the other sub-funds.

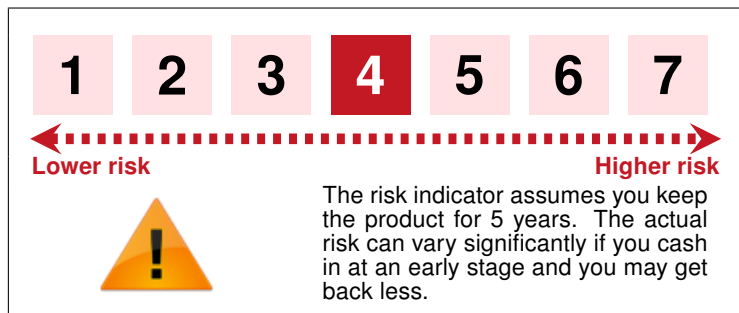

## What happens if Spuerkeess Asset Management S.A. is unable to pay out?

If we are not able to pay you out what we owe you, you are not covered by any national compensation or guarantee scheme. To protect you, the assets are held with a separate company, the depositary Banque et Caisse d'Epargne de l'Etat, Luxembourg. Should we default, the investments are liquidated and the proceeds are distributed to the investors. In the worst case, however, you could lose your entire investment.

## What are the costs?

### Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. ## How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

**Recommended holding period: 5 years**
